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1 *Carpinus* x 'Shelby'

An upright, narrow deciduous tree with deep-green, serrated foliage that maintains its slender habit as it matures. This American x European hybrid develops attractive fluted bark with age and is ideal for tight spaces, streetscapes, and formal landscapes. Low-maintenance and drought-tolerant once established.

2 *Cephalotaxus harringtonia* 'Prostrata'

A low-spreading evergreen conifer with fragrant, glossy, needle-like foliage, providing year-round interest. Its slow-growing, mounding habit is ideal for groundcover, borders, and shaded areas, while its deer- and rabbit-resistance makes it a low-maintenance landscape choice.

3 *Cercis canadensis* 'Garden Gems Amethyst'

A compact, well-branched habit makes this deciduous tree perfect for small gardens and container plantings. Abundant, pollinator-attracting pink blooms in spring make way for rich, burgundy, heart-shaped foliage that is retained through summer's heat and beyond. bloomables.com

4 *Cercis canadensis* 'Garden Gems Emerald'

A compact, well-branched habit makes this deciduous tree an elegant focal point in small gardens or when potted on patios. A spring flush of pink blooms will attract pollinators. Lush red-to-green, heart-shaped foliage brings a striking contrast in summer and early fall. bloomables.com

5 *Chionanthus retusus* 'Tokyo Tower'

A narrow, upright ornamental tree with fragrant white flowers in late spring, with dark-green foliage that turns bright yellow in fall. Exfoliating tan and gold bark adds winter interest, while blue-black fruit attracts birds. Ideal for small landscapes and specimen plantings.

6 *Cornus kousa* 'Rutpink (Scarlet Fire)' PP28311

A rare, eye-catching flowering tree with deep-pink to fuchsia bracts in late spring that stand out against its dark green foliage. An upright, rounded habit, decorative red summer fruit, and good disease tolerance make it an excellent choice for specimen plantings and small landscapes.

7 *Heptacodium miconoides*

A large, multi-stemmed deciduous shrub or small tree with fragrant creamy-white late-summer flowers, followed by rose-pink calyces and persistent fruit. Features exfoliating tan bark and has drought- and salt-tolerance. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.

8 *Pinus koraiensis* 'Golden Eye'

A slow-growing, compact evergreen conifer with gold-and-green variegated needles for year-round color. A globose, dwarf pine discovered as a witch's broom on 'Oculus Draconis' by Eric Bizon, retaining bold variegation in a smaller, denser form. Thrives in well-drained soil, ideal for rock gardens, containers and small landscapes.

9 *Pinus mugo* 'Merfn's Choice'

An exceptionally hardy, narrow, columnar evergreen providing strong vertical structure for tight spaces. Dense dark-green needles and silvery-white resin-coated winter buds add contrast, with reddish-orange bark and small cones for year-round interest. Durable, low-maintenance, and ideal for foundations, entryways, screens and vertical accents.

10 *Pinus nigra* 'Compacta'

A slower-growing Austrian Pine with rich dark-green needles and a dense, compact habit. Tough and adaptable, it provides year-round evergreen color and works well for foundations, screens and windbreaks. More manageable in size than typical Austrian Pine while retaining its rugged, durable character.

11 *Pinus nigra* 'Green Tower'

A sturdy, narrow, columnar evergreen with dark-green needles providing year-round color and strong vertical form. Slow-growing and ideal for tight spaces, it works well as a specimen, hedge or windbreak. Strong branching improves resistance to snow and ice, and it thrives in full sun with low maintenance and tolerance to drought, clay, salt and urban conditions.

12 *Prunus laurocerasus* 'Sofia' PP33411P2

Compact evergreen tree with narrow, glossy, serrated, dark-green leaves. Naturally dense and small, ideal for hedges, screens, specimens or topiary. Produces creamy-white spring flowers and is valued for evergreen foliage, disease resistance, and reliable performance from full sun to shade.

13 *Quercus macrocarpa*

A native deciduous oak valued for longevity, rugged adaptability, and a broad, stately canopy. Deeply-lobed green leaves turn yellow-brown in fall, while thick corky bark and fringed acorns add year-round interest. Extremely tolerant of drought, heat, cold, urban conditions, and varied soils, it forms a durable, long-lived shade tree.

14 *Thuja occidentalis* 'American Pillar' PP20209

A narrow, upright evergreen selection of the native American Arborvitae, known for its dense, deep-green foliage and columnar form that adds strong vertical structure year-round. It is hardy, low-maintenance, and well-suited for screens, hedges or vertical accents. fullspeedahedge.com

15 *Thuja occidentalis* 'Tiny Tim'

A dwarf, evergreen shrub with dense, scale-like, deep-green foliage forming a neat, rounded mound. Ideal for rock gardens, borders, containers or small landscapes, as it stays compact with minimal pruning. Thrives in well-drained soil, providing year-round color and structure. A hardy North American arborvitae valued for adaptability and evergreen interest.
